## Intercession

Trusting God requires that we long for His presence and live for His glory.

### *As You Go*

These are simple questions to ask your students as you go home from church or go about your weekly activities.

**.01 HAS ANYONE EVER STEPPED IN WHEN YOU'VE BEEN SICK OR SAD TO HELP OR ENCOURAGE YOU? SHARE THAT STORY.**

**.02 WHAT ARE SOME THINGS YOU AND YOUR FRIENDS LONG FOR AND DESIRE TO DO?**

### *Family Devotion*

Consider following up with your student later in the week with the following summary and discussion questions.

#### Summary: Exodus 33:1-3,12-23

This week we see Moses ask God for something astounding—to see His glory. Challenge your son or daughter to long for God's presence and desire to see His glory. God made us for the purpose of glorifying Him. In order to trust God, we must long for His presence and live for His glory.

#### Discussion Questions

**.01 MOSES PRAYED ON BEHALF OF THE ISRAELITES AND ASKED TO SEE GOD'S GLORY. WHO IN YOUR LIFE DO YOU NEED TO PRAY FOR AND SHARE CHRIST WITH THIS WEEK?**

**.02 MOSES LONGED FOR GOD'S PRESENCE. HOW CAN WE SEEK TO GLORIFY GOD AND LIVE FOR HIS GLORY THIS WEEK?**

**Pray:** Ask God to give you a renewed passion for His Word and for His presence in your life. Be honest and tell Him where you are and where you lack trust in Him this week. Pray that God would give you a longing passion for Him.



#### "No man can see God and live..."

- Read Genesis 3:8-10. Adam and Eve heard the sound of the LORD, but nothing is said about them seeing God.
- Read Exodus 24:9-11. In these verses Moses and the seventy elders saw God in some shape or form that is not clear. They did not see His face though, for if they did, they would die (Ex. 33:20).
- Go back and read Exodus 33:11 again. Moses was not forbidden from seeing God's actual face. This is a metaphor with "God's face" representing the fullness of His glory. No sinful person can see the fullness of His glory and live.
