As You Go

Family Devotion

Consider following up with your student later in the week with the following summary and discussion questions.

Summary: Leviticus 26:3–16,40–45

This week as we continue our study in the Book of Leviticus, we saw how God promises to bless those who are faithful to Him and He promises to discipline those who are not. God will remember His promises as He remembered His covenant with His people.

Discussion Questions

.01 GOD IS NOT FORGETFUL. HE WILL REMEMBER HIS PROMISES. HOW DOES SCRIPTURE REMIND YOU OF HIS FAITHFULNESS AND HOW HE KEEPS HIS WORD?

.02 GOD DISCIPLINES THOSE HE LOVES (HEB. 12:6). IS GOD DISCIPLINING YOU? HOW MIGHT YOU NEED TO GET BACK ON TRACK?

Pray: Thank God for His faithfulness and for always keeping His promises. Ask Him to help you trust Him more and to give you the confidence to share His promises and His truth with others this week.
