

**Preservice Meeting (6:00-6:10)**

*Scatter Categories*

Supplies

Microphone or a loud voice

Setup

Have a list of items that you will call out

The Game

Ask everyone to stand up and listen as you call out the name of a general category, such as gum, ice cream, or cars. Players must yell the name of their favorite item in the category and find all the other players who share a love for that item. For example, if the category is candy bars, players form a group that includes fans of a particular candy bar.

After groups have formed ask them to shout out their subcategories to see if they have found all their group members. To get player's attention after they scatter to various groups, stay in a place where you can be easily seen and heard.

Follow-up questions

- What surprising commonalities does our group have here?
- Did you opt for a second choice favorite because it was easier than forming your own group? If so, how does your choice relate to positive and negative peer pressure?
- What did you learn about yourself during this activity? How might you work to grow stronger?
- In our study tonight we will discuss times when we know we need to speak up.
